Arrival in Jena

By Car:

The north-south and east-west highways of the A9 Berlin-Munich motorways and the A4 Dresden-Eisenach-Frankfurt/Main intersect near Jena. Jena itself is connected twice in the city area to the A4 Dresden-Eisenach-Frankfurt/Main via the Jena-Zentrum and Jena-Göschwitz junctions. Access to the A9 Berlin-Nuremberg is via the nearby Hermsdorfer Kreuz. Jena can be reached via federal highways via the B88 Naumburg–Jena–Rudolstadt and the B7 Eisenach-Erfurt-Weimar-Jena-Eisenberg.

By train:

With 3 local and long-distance train stations and a well-developed east-west and north-south connection, Jena is easy to reach by train:

Jena Paradiesbahnhof (North-South connection | IC stop),

Jena Westbahnhof (East-West connection | IR stop), Jena-Göschwitz (Junction station)

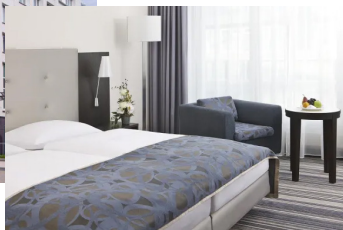
Airports:

The most common arrival airports for international flights are Berlin (BER), Frankfurt/Main (FRA) and Munich (MUC). From there, Jena can be reached within 3.5 or 4.5 hours by train.

Dorint Esplanade

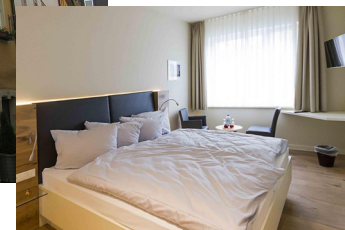

Hotel „Zur Noll“



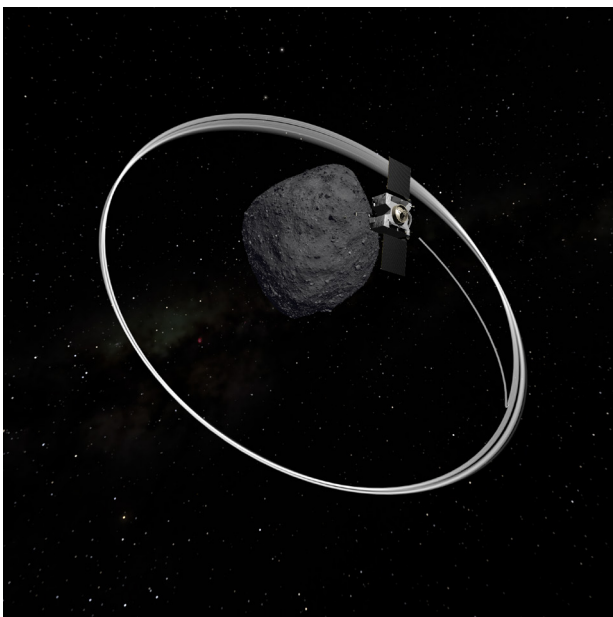
